

Stanwell Energy Retail Accredited Green Power

Stanwell Energy is an accredited Green Power provider for its current and potential customers providing them with the choice to make a positive contribution to the environment by sourcing all or some of their electricity needs from renewable energy sources. Stanwell has two hydro power stations which produce no net greenhouse gas emission:

- Koombooloomba Hydro located in Far North Queensland; and
- Wivenhoe Small Hydro located in the Wivenhoe Dam wall.

Alternatively, Stanwell Energy can also source Green Power from other accredited Green Power generators in the National Electricity Market.

What is GreenPower?

GreenPower is Australia's government managed accreditation program helping the nation transition to renewable energy above and beyond legislated targets.



The GreenPower authority audits suppliers and accredits generators to ensure the renewable electricity you buy through Stanwell Energy meets strict environmental standards.

As a customer of GreenPower, you can elect to source 100 per cent of your electricity requirements. Alternatively, you can source a percentage of your electricity ranging from one to 99 per cent.

Customers electing to source GreenPower are entitled to use GreenPower logos on marketing material to promote their contribution to reducing greenhouse emissions.



How does it work?

Energy sourced under the GreenPower program does not feed directly into a customer's power supply. It feeds into the electricity grid, which supplies electricity to all customers, and is made up of a mix of generation sources.
